











Multistate Grant Background

What is the MSCGP?

- The Multistate Conservation Grant Program ("MSCGP") provides funding for wildlife and sport fish restoration projects identified as priority projects by the Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies (the "Association").
- These high-priority projects address problems affecting states on a regional or national basis.
- Project types that are generally selected for funding are: biological research/training; species population status research; outreach and data collection regarding hunter/angler participation; hunter/aquatic education; economic value of fishing/hunting; and regional or multistate habitat needs assessments.















Grant Administration

Who administers the MSCGP?

- The MSCGP is cooperatively administered by the Association of Fish & Wildlife Agencies and U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service - Wildlife and Sport Fish Restoration Program (USFWS-WSFR).
- AFWA administers the grant application process, providing oversight, coordination, and guidance for the MSCGP while the USFWS-WSFR awards, manages, and distributes the grant funding for projects dedicated to fish and wildlife restoration.













MSCGP Funding Source

- Funding is available each calendar year from the following resources:
 - 1. Wildlife Restoration Account: WR funding is collected from the excise tax that manufacturers, producers, and importers pay on shooting, archery, and angling equipment.
 - 2. Sport Fish Restoration & Boating Trust Fund: SFR funding is collected from the excise tax that recreational boaters pay on fuel and electric motors.
