IN 2023

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service provided \$5.8 Million for 95 onthe-ground conservation projects across 24 States. Partners provided a 5.7-to-1 funding match with an additional \$33.3 million supporting projects.

The National Fish Habitat Partnership has implemented over 1,300 conservation projects spanning all 50 States.
