FY2022 Conservation Priorities

- ACE Act Title II Section 201(2) requirement
- Current Interim Priorities passed in April 2021
 - Protect intact healthy waters
 - Restore hydrologic conditions for fish
 - Reconnect fragmented fish habitats
 - Restore water quality
 - Coordination and operational support for FHPs to make on-theground progress within program appropriations
- By October, Board needs to have a set of Conservation Priorities to guide FHPs for FY2023





NFHP Conservation Priorities

- SDC asked to develop a set of potential options
 Draft set by September will be provided to the Board
- Three workgroups formed around systems
 - Rivers and Streams
 - Lakes and Reservoirs
 - Coastal and Great Lakes

 - Specific quantitative options?
 - Do Board members have some suggested priorities for evaluation?
 - Parameters to be considered?
